

Make Your Own Zebra-Striped Pinwheel

Spread Hope and Awareness of Worldwide NET Cancer Day by Making and Displaying Your Own Pinwheel

Join our **Hope Is Like Air** campaign by displaying zebra-striped pinwheels to raise awareness of neuroendocrine tumor (NET) cancer. NET cancer is represented by zebra stripes. Follow the instructions below to create your own zebra-striped pinwheel. Show them off at home, in your office, or even ask a local business to display some. See if you can cover your community with these pinwheels and help bring awareness to this often misdiagnosed form of cancer.

1. Print the pinwheel template on letter-size paper. Following the dashed lines, cut out the square. Then cut along the diagonal, dashed lines.
2. Use a pushpin to poke holes in the center of the pinwheel and in the 4 corners. Twist the pin to make the holes smooth. This will help the pinwheel spin.
3. Gently bend each corner with a hole (zebra side facing up) to line up with the center hole (see diagram).
4. Stick the pushpin through each of the corner holes, through the center hole, and then into the top of a pencil eraser (see diagram).
5. With a puff of air, blow on your pinwheel and spread hope!
